Deputy Registrar Training

The Hall County Election Office will be offering three training sessions for registered voters to become a Deputy Registrar – a volunteer who is trained and certified to register people to vote.

The one-hour training is free and open to registered voters who desire to assist in the election process by registering voters at community registration events. The certification obtained is good for three years or until substantive changes are made to the Deputy Registrar process.

The trainings will be offered on the first floor of the Hall County Administration Building, 121 S. Pine Street at the following times:

Thursday, January 4, 2018 at 5:15 p.m. Monday, January 22, 2018 at noon. Thursday, January 25, 2018 at 8:30 a.m.
