### **Voter Registration Events**

Hall County deputy registrars will be hosting two voter registration events this weekend. One will be held from 3 to 5 p.m. Friday, April 20 at the Grand Island Public Library, 211 N. Washington. The other will be held from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Sunday, April 22 at Super Saver, 1602 W. Second St.

“This is a great time for Hall County voters to update their records prior to the May 15 Primary Election - or for first-time voters to get registered,” said Hall County Election Commissioner Tracy Overstreet. “Voters who have had a change of name, a change of address or who want to change their party affiliation need to update their voter registration information.”

Voters can also go online to register or update their information by using their Nebraska driver’s license number. The online voter registration link can be found on the Hall County website at [hallcountyne.gov](http://hallcountyne.gov) under the Election Commission tab.

The last day for voters to register or change information online is April 30 in order to be registered for the May 15 primary. The last day for voters to register or change information in person is May 4 when the Hall County Election Office will remain open until 6 p.m. at 121 S. Pine St.

Hall County has nearly 30,000 active registered voters. As of April 19, there are 15,151 Republicans, 8,111 Democratic, 286 Libertarians and 5,893 Nonpartisan voters.
