Shall the city of Wood River, Nebraska, under the provisions of Chapter 19, Article 7, of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, acquire and appropriate for the public use by the exercise of the power of eminent domain, the natural gas distribution system owned by K N Energy, Inc., a Kansas corporation, domesticated in Nebraska, with a billing address of Lakewood, Colorado, located or operating partly within and partly without the City of Wood River, Nebraska, including the gas distribution system and gas pipelines, and consisting of pressure regulation systems, gas mains, service connections, meters, and other equipment and all parts, tangible and intangible of said gas system, needed and useful in the distribution and sale of natural gas and the rendering of gas service partly within and partly without the City of Wood River, Nebraska?

Proposed by Initiative Measure 407

Shall the Nebraska Constitution be amended to: (1) set limits of two consecutive terms in office for Nebraska Legislators, the Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts, Treasurer, Attorney General, Public Service Commissioners, State Board of Education members, and University of Nebraska Board of Regents members; and (2) prohibit persons who have served four consecutive terms as a Representative in Congress or two consecutive terms in the U.S. Senate from being listed on any official ballot for re-election. Terms currently being served would not be counted in applying these restrictions.
