Wood River Rural High School Propostition

Shall there be adopted a plan to expand the grade offerings of Hall County School District 40-0083-000, commonly known as Wood River Rural High School, to include the 6th grade, making it a Class VI, 6th through 12th grade school district, and making Hall County School District 40-0008-000, commonly known as Wood River Elementary School, Hall County School District 40-0012-000, commonly known as Alda Public Schools, and Hall County School District 40-0016-000, commonly known as Plainview Public Schools Class I, Kindergarten through 5th grade school districts, according to the terms and conditions in the plan, which plan is on file with each of the school districts, and which plan generally provides for the grade level changes to be effective on or about August 31, 2004.

Grand Island Sales and Use Tax Proposal

Shall the Mayor and City Council of the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, impose a sales and use tax in the amount of one-half percent (1/2%) in addition to the one percent (1%) currently in effect, upon the same transactions within the City of Grand Island on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax and shall the City of Grand Island increase its budgeted restricted funds for fiscal year 2004-2005 by \$4.5 million over the current year's restricted funds with one-half of the proceeds collected therefrom to be used for property tax relief and one-half of the proceeds used for capital improvements including, but not limited to, fire department facilities, police department facilities, parks and recreation facilities, senior/Grand Generation facilities and infrastructure?
